The target numbers for Part C and At Risk ongoing services represent point-in-time targets and not cumulative target numbers. In other words, the expectation is that counties, at any time during the fiscal year, should have the specified number of children under the age of three, with an At Risk or Part C eligibility and an IFSP being served and entered into Early Track.

The target number for Newborn Home Visits is a cumulative number for the entire fiscal year.
