This amount will be subtracted from the AG's full monthly allotment (line 1). It will also be subtracted from any changes in the AG's allotment during the OWF/DA penalty period. However, if all members of the OWF/DA AG being penalized no longer live together, go to step 4.</p>	<p>\$ _____ Line 3</p>
4.	<p>If this situation is not applicable, enter N/A on line 4.</p> <p>If members of the FS AG who were not a part of the original OWF/DA penalized AG leave the FS AG, the amount on line 3 continues to be subtracted from the FS allotment for the remaining members. If a member moves who is part of the OWF/DA AG being penalized he/she takes a portion of the amount on line 3 with him/her.</p> <p>Step 4 is to be completed in situations where the members of the OWF/DA AG being penalized no longer live together.
